Main Work Party reports.

1st July—Lingwood Church—Conservation area raked and cleared with the 'green hay' been taken and spread over Jary's Meadow.

15th July—Blofield Church—The areas to the left and right of gravel path leading to the church, raked and cleared to spoil heaps.

29th July—Jary's Meadow—The grassy hollow & the gate area, a large central area, the small boggy area bordering the fen, the fine grassy area below the seat and the eastern path network all raked and cleared to the fire sites. Additionally, the encroaching shrub and vegetation along the bridleway, cut back with hedge trimmer.

12th August—Howes Meadow—All areas mown on the 8th August, raked and cleared to the northern edge of the meadow ready for further clearance at a later date.

19th August—Howes Meadow—All areas mown on the 17th raked and cleared either to the western fire site, or to the north side of the meadow or into rows ready for moving and burning at a later date.

Additional work.

6th July—Blofield Church—The whole of the churchyard mown ready for the main work party. Strimmers also used around gravestones.

7th July—Southwood Church— Churchyard mown ready for the BVCV to clear. Note: BVCV cleared churchyard on the 12th July.


18th July—Blofield Church—The 'Green Gym' finished off the clearance of the churchyard.
