Food repository: The Village Hall is building a food repository. The intention is that it can be used to support the most vulnerable in our parish if things get really tough for anyone. Please do not go buying lots in order to help this – we don't want you arrested for panic buying! If any of you are desperately in need of something and cannot get out, please call the Hall to see if we have it. This is a limited service which is intended as a last resort.
