

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the Wood Lane from 100m west of its junction with Strumpshaw Road for 690m westwards in the PARISH OF BUCKENHAM because of BT Openreach HV Polling works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 26th to 28th September 2022 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Wood Lane, Stone Road, Long Lane, Strumpshaw Road, Blofield Road, Brundall Road, Stocks Lane, Yarmouth Road, The Street, North Street, Plantation Road, A47 From Blofield Parish Boundary To Lingwood Parish Boundary, A47 From J A1042 To Start Of Dualling East Of Blofield Excluding Roundabouts E, A47 From Start Of Dualling West Of J B1140 To Start Of Dualling East Of Blofield, A47 Yarmouth Road, A47 From Start Of Dualling West Of J B1140 To J A1064 W, A47 From Acle Parish Boundary To Halvergate Parish Boundary, Acle Road, Coxhill Road, High Road, Norwich Road. (Beighton, Cantley, Limpenhoe and Southwood, Brundall, Lingwood and Burlingham, Strumpshaw, Blofield).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
