

**Norfolk County Council  
(Lingwood and Burlingham) (Emergency Notice)  
Temporary Traffic Restriction 2022  
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to a burst water main, the use by vehicles of the Buckenham Lane from 215m north of its junction with Buckenham Road for 40m northwards in the PARISH OF LINGWOOD AND BURLINGHAM will be temporarily prohibited from between 22:00 and 23:59 from 20<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> October 2022 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 7 days within the period. If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.

Alternative route is via: Buckenham Lane, Norwich Road, Buckenham Road, Strumpshaw Road (Lingwood and Burlingham, Strumpshaw).

(If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
