NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO5876) affecting the High Road from its junction with Cantley Road for 50m northwards in the PARISH OF CANTLEY, LIMPENHOE AND SOUTHWOOD to facilitate water connection works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 3rd to 5th April 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: High Road, Norwich Road, Coxhill Road, Acle Road, Lodge Road, School Road, Station Road, Long Lane, Stone Road, Wood Lane, Strumpshaw Road (Cantley, Limpenhoe and Southwood, Beighton, Lingwood and Burlingham, Strumpshaw).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.


In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
