

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO6324) affecting Wood Lane from 300m west from its junction with Stone Road for 200m westwards in the PARISH OF STRUMPSHAW to facilitate access for new duct works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 09:30 and 15:30 from 10th to 12th April 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Wood Lane, Stone Road, Long Lane, Norwich Road, High Road, Strumpshaw Road (Beighton, Cantley, Limpenhoe and Southwood, Lingwood and Burlingham, Strumpshaw).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

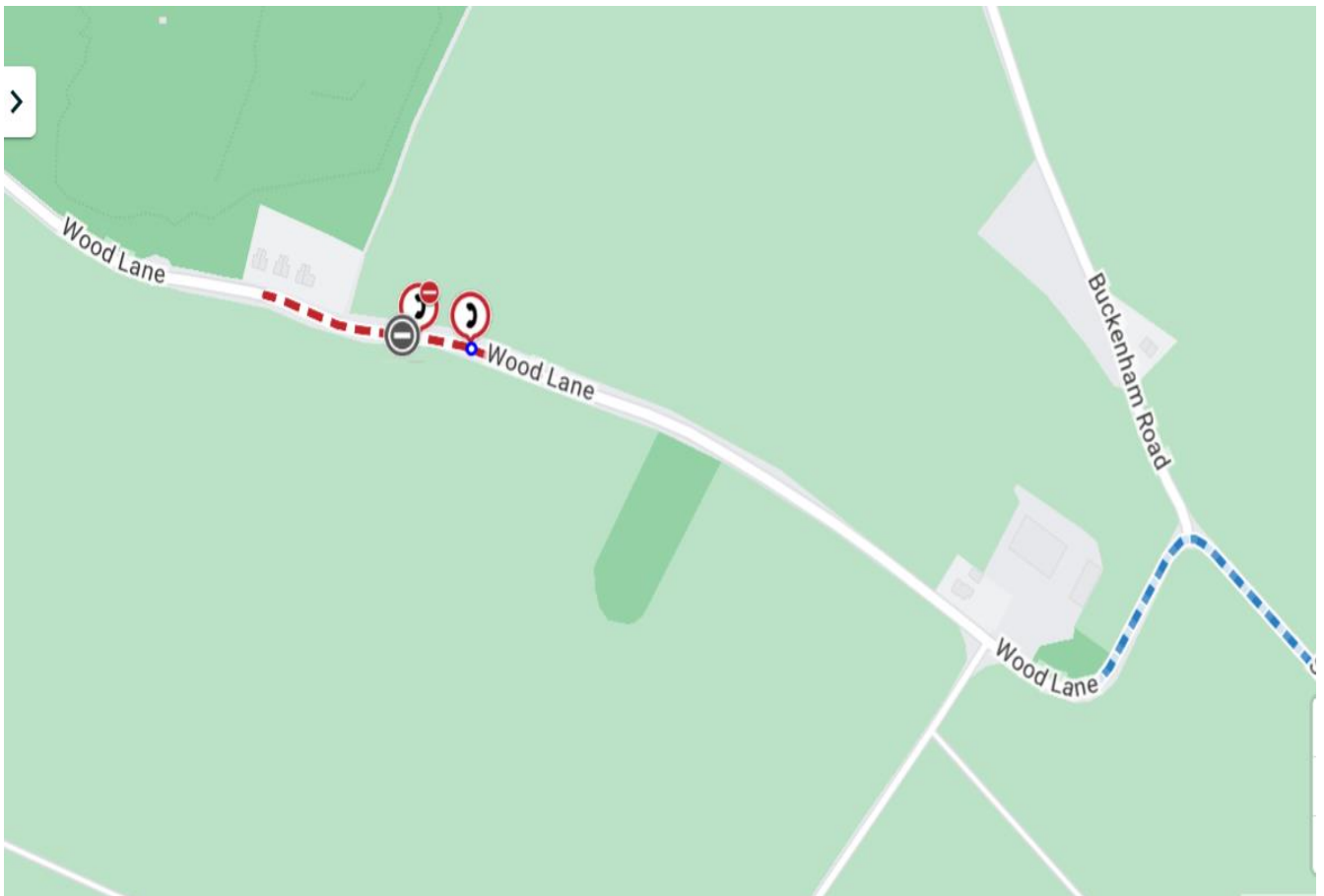
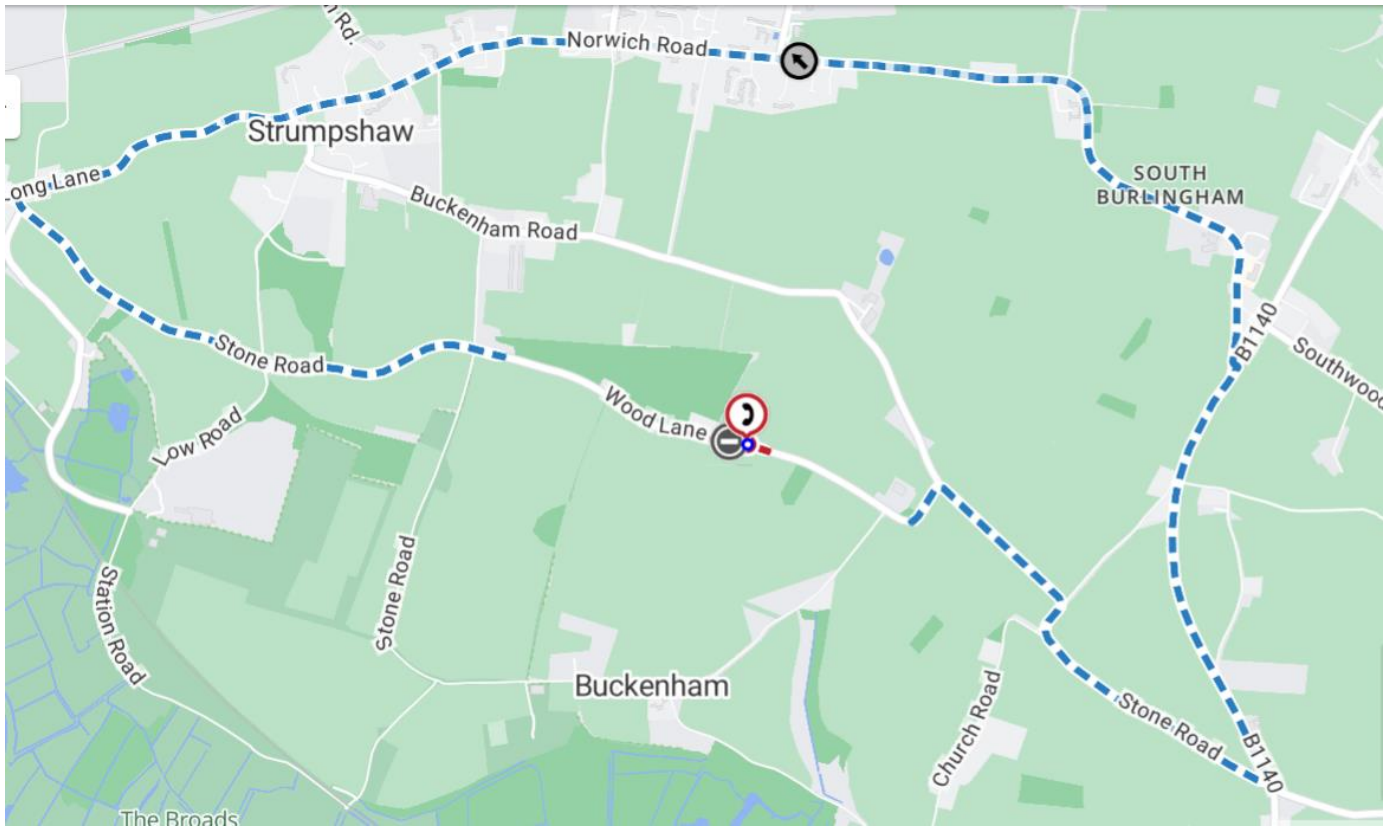
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
