

# LINGWOOD & BURLINGHAM PARISH COUNCIL

## Notes of Galliford Try, mini public information event, prior to the Parish Council Meeting on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2023 at 7 pm.

**Present were** – Chair David Robinson, Cheryl Grace, Mike Ingram, Roz Simpson, Jenny Stafford, Ian White and Sonya Dickinson – Clerk.

**Welcome and Apologies for absence:** Apologies were received from Vice Chair Richard Morton and Ian Chapman.

We were joined by Rob Norman and his team from Galliford Try, members of Reedham and Cantley Parish Council and 4 members of the Public.

Rob – The legal process was against the Dept of Transport but the Judge has ruled it can go ahead. They are challenging the Judge's decision but National Highways feel happy to continue. Are there any questions about the road closures?

Waterlow Road is closed until the A47 is finished.

Yarmouth Road junction is closed for 3-4 weeks.

High Noon from 25<sup>th</sup> September and Lingwood Road will be closed for a gas diversion on 2<sup>nd</sup> October.

9<sup>th</sup> October Lingwood Lane will be closed.

2<sup>nd</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> October (Mon-Fri) the A47 will be closed.

11<sup>th</sup> September the B1140 Acle Road will be closed for 2 weeks.

Q. Is there potential that for a time you will have to stop? A. Possibly, but there is a 6 month lead time until the main roadwork starts, so we shouldn't be held up by the judicial process. (National infrastructure Document is what is being challenged).

The A47 central crossing point, near the White House will be closed temporarily, while South Walsham Road junction work is carried out.

The A47 central reservation, opposite to Yarmouth Road will be permanently closed.

It should be open to traffic from July 2025.

If there are any projects you want, apply for designated funds. National Highways will deal with it (on their website).

Night time closures will be 8pm to 6am.
