

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7403) affecting Burlingham Road 260m south from its junction with B1140 Chameryhall Lane for 150m southwards in the PARISH OF SOUTH WALSHAM to facilitate BT pole testing works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) on 5<sup>th</sup> February 2024 for the duration of the works expected to be about 1 day within the period.

Alternative route is via: Burlingham Road, Dell Corner Lane, A47 Trunk Road, B1140 South Walsham Road / Newport Road, Burlingham Road (South Walsham, Lingwood and Burlingham).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
