Referendum on the adoption of the Lingwood & Burlingham Neighbourhood Plan

1. A referendum will be held on **2 May 2024** to decide on the question below:
‘Do you want Broadland District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Lingwood & Burlingham to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?’
2. Applications be included in the register of electors for this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Horizon Centre, Peachman Way, Broadland Business Park, Norwich, NR7 0WF by **midnight on Tuesday, 16 April 2024**. 3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday, 17 April 2024** if they are to be effective for this election. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote>
4. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector’s document valid for this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2024**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate>
5. Applications for a proxy vote at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2024**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote>
6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by not later than **5pm on Thursday, 2 May 2024**. Note: there are specific criteria that apply to emergency proxy applications.
